### **ROTTINGDEAN BAZAAR**

Multidisciplinary creatives James Theseus Buck and Luke Brooks began working together in late 2015 and Rottingdean Bazaar was born after moving to the seaside village of Rottingdean in East Sussex. SS18 is Rottingdean Bazaar's third season with the support of Fashion East and their first at MAN. Their work takes shape around a perversely original use of found objects. Previous collections feature an array of objects sealed onto wearable garments, the likes of pressed flowers, underwear, tights and balloons are incorporated into clothing, accessories, artworks and installations. The pair also art direct and style shoots including for Man About Town, Buffalo Zine, Marfa Journal and Dazed.
